Some of the lodges are showing an increase, but we also have others that are consolidating to keep operating or some have opted to surrender the Charter. I really hate to see a lodge close down.






The Grand Patriarch will visit Temple Encampment # 3 on APRIL 11, 2011 and there will be the annual Fish Fry served to all that wish to attend.


Royal Gem Rebekah Lodge #13 Installs New Officers
