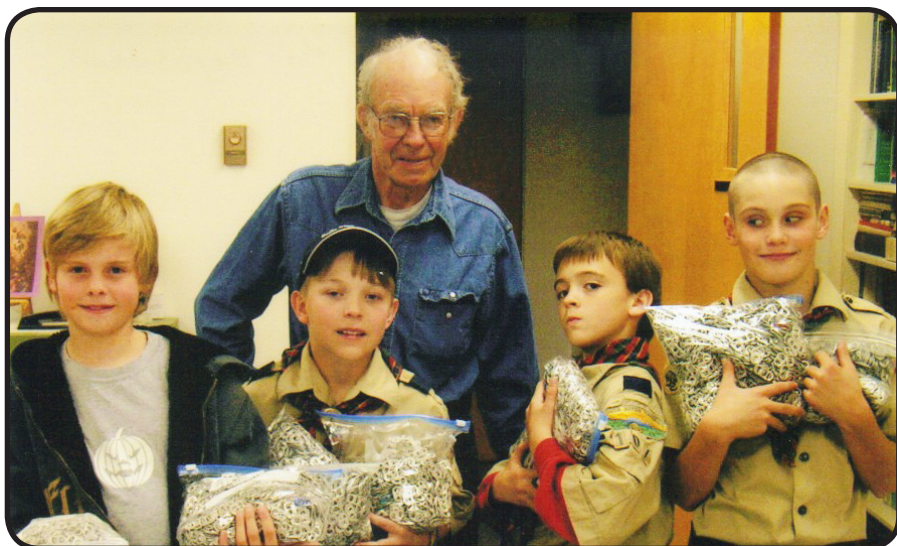

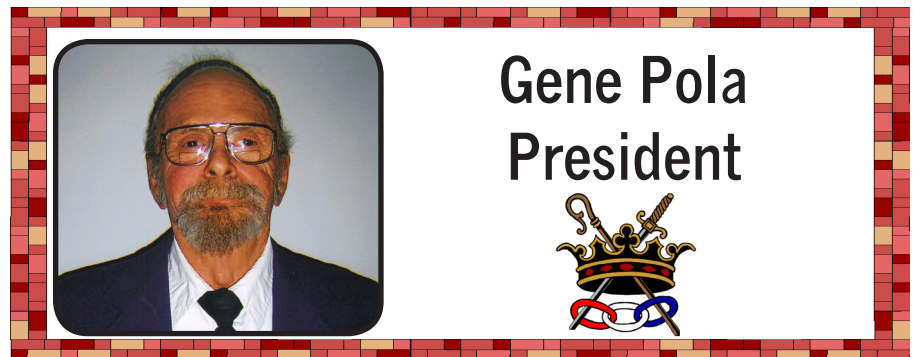
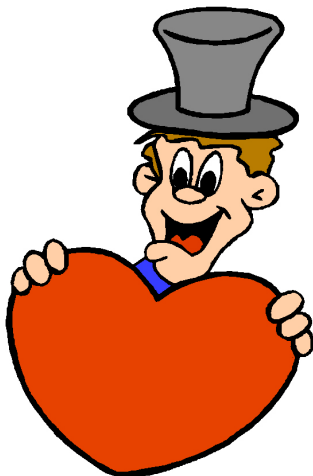
Some of the lodges are showing an increase, but we also have others that are consolidating to keep operating or some have opted to surrender the Charter. I really hate to see a lodge close down.
