On January 2, 2012 the Odd Fellows and Rebekahs Rose Parade float, Shining Knights Still Exist, received the Isabella Coleman Trophy from the Tournament of Roses for the the best presentation of color combinations and color harmony. This makes our 3rd consecutive trophy, as our 2010 and 2011 floats each received the Princess trophy. Odd Fellows and Rebekahs floats have often been recognized by the parade judges over the past half century for the complex and painstakingly precise detail of our workmanship.

Our float is viewed by approximately 1 million people on the parade route and many more millions via the television broadcasting channels. It is even viewed in China. This is truly a very large viewing audience that has seen and heard our name.

For instance, in the absence of a Financial Secretary, the Secretary automatically inherits that job. If there are any questions on what your duties are, please check the current by-laws.

There is not much "new" news as of this time as you all read the last month's paper. Your DDGM has received a request for member information from your lodge, so please assist them in this project.

Most everything is running as smoothly as it can with the transition of personnel in the office and will improve as time goes on. Again the Grand Lodge officers have decreased your annual Per Capita dues for the year 2012 to \$20.00 per member.

The new up-dated Constitution/Bylaws are in the office and available to those that wants to keep current with the operations of the organization. Each lodge has been issued one. The others are \$5.00 per copy. If there is any doubt of being current, check page 49 for lodge fees "E-F-G". If they are not in it, you are NOT current. When you get current, get rid of the "old" one to avoid confusion.

The 2010 Code changes are available through the office if your lodge has not ordered them. The cost is \$5.00 each including tax and freight.

Please fill out <u>all</u> information of a new member and forward to the Grand Lodge office so the records can be updated. There is a form for this in the IOOF News from S.G.L. each time, or contact the Grand Secretary. (<u>Please</u> include phone number of member)

To alleviate any confusion as to what approved Resolution No. 3 entails, I will try to explain what took place at Grand Sessions.

This is a completely new program and has nothing to do with what has been done in the past. It simply approved a Special Deputy being appointed to head up an Ad-Hoc Committee to prioritize a system to help individual lodges maintain their lodges under certain controlled conditions. 






Dear Brothers and Sisters.
