(a) Place Officers Regalia at the proper stations

- (b) Have Members Regalia arranged in the Anti Room
- (c) Place Visitors Register where it is easily accessible
- (d) Place the Bible in the proper place
- (e) Place the US Flag to the right of the Noble Grand

(f) Place a gavel on the station of the Noble Grand and Vice Grand Previous to the Opening Ceremony the Noble Grand should ascertain if all Officers are present and be prepared to fill any vacancies.




Dear Lodge Secretary:


