

PILGRIMAGE INFORMATION FOR 2024

"Greetings Brothers and Sisters

It is once again time to start the selection process for delegates that will be attending the 76th Pilgrimage for Youth Tour. The tour dates are June 29-July 12 and begin and end in Philadelphia.

This year we had 75 delegates representing 23 jurisdictions. The speech contest winner this year was Claira Luzmore from Wyoming who will receive a \$2,000 scholarship. Second place ended in a tie between Ayana Ray Mejorado from Wyoming and Madeline Drummond from Alberta. Both will receive a \$1,000 scholarship. Congratulations to all the scholarship winners.

The Pilgrimage for Youth Board met on August 18, in Des Moines, IA and set the dates of June 29-July 12 for the 2024 tour. Also, several changes were made to the program:

- Delegates Fees will be \$2,100 for 2024. This is the first raise since 2017. The total cost this year was \$2,740 per delegate. The difference in cost is made up through generous donations from our lodges, individuals and sponsors. A huge thank you to all who support our program.
- All fees are to be made at one time instead of two deposits. This year we had (7) delegates
 drop out in the month prior to the start the tour. Tickets, Restaurant contracts, etc have to be
 ordered well in advance and are non-refundable. We lost several thousand dollars because of
 this. There will be no refunds! If a student drops out after the deadline to submit their fee and
 applications then you have time to replace them.
- All delegates must start the tour on the beginning date and stay with the tour until its end date.
- Tour Leader fees have been set at \$1,200.

Tour Dates: June 29-July12, 2024 Delegate fees: \$2,100.00 All Delegate fees and Applications are due by Feb. 1, 2024 Staff and Tour Leader applications due by November 1, 2023 Tour Leader fees: \$1,200.00 (if selected) Delegates must be 16/17 years old and have at least one year of high school remaining to be eligible. EXAMINATION

Question: Who Orders the Examination of members presentAnswer: Noble Grand or Vice Grand in the absence of the Noble Grand

Procedures: When addressed by the Noble Grand the Warden and Conductor will arise and face the Noble Grand. Having received their instructions to examine those present, they will turn toward each other and advance until they meet, then face toward the Noble Grand.

The Warden will then advance to Noble Grand and receive from Him or Her the passwords. He will then return and receive the passwords from the Conductor. They will then proceed to examine all those present, beginning with the supporters of the Noble Grand. The Warden will examine those on the right and the Conductor those on the left of the Noble Grand.

In conducting the examination of the members, the Warden and Conductor take a position one pace in front of the Brother or Sister to be examined. That Brother or Sister rises, steps over to the officer and communicates the passwords as instructed in the ritual. The Warden and Conductor so proceed until all present have been examined. The officer reaching the inner door will proceed to the anteroom and examine any who may be there.

NEXT MONTH: Examining members without the necessary Passwords.

Remember: "If a Thing is worth doing, it's worth doing well" That old adage is also true when conducting our lodge work!!


Sovereign Grand Lodge 2023
